During the time of the **Rev Ronald Barras 1964 – 1972** An unknown number of gravestones believed to have been broken or dangerous were removed from this Churchyard, no records appertaining to this have been found. This part of the graveyard is thought to have been fully used, owing to the removal of these gravestones it is impossible to compile a complete record.

The following details are a record of the inscriptions on all the graves at present. There are problems connected with badly eroded or flaking gravestones or those encrusted with lichen which has made it difficult, in some cases impossible to record fully, though every effort has been made.

Please note many of the rows are out of alignment throughout.

Zone B. Grave 1. THY WILL BE DONE. Memory of WILLIAM MATTHEWS who died April 18. 1883 aged ? years (The remainder of the inscription is flaked off)

Zone B. Grave 2. Loving memory of LUCY the beloved wife of WILLIAM SMITH who died June 16th 1885 In her 35th year. **(Burial record, shows 33 years)** "I HEARD THE VOICE OF JESUS SAY COME UNTO ME AND REST LAY DOWN THOU WEARY ONE LAY DOWN THY HEAD UPON MY BREAST".

Zone B. Grave 3. Loving memory of JAMES FREEMAN who entered into rest Jan 22nd 1900 aged 87 years. THE SOULS OF THE RIGHTEOUS ARE THE HAND OF GOD AND THERE SHALL NO TORMENT TOUCH THEM IN THE SIGHT OF THE UNWISE THEY SEEMED TO DIE BUT THEY ARE IN PEACE.

Zone B. Grave 6. Three Plinths with a Cross inscribed on all four sides:

North: FREDERICK NOEL ANDERSON PHILIPS BROWNE of Whimble Devon, and Emery Down, Hampshire died 28th May 1981 Son of REGINALD AND JANET EDITH.

East: BEATRICE only Daughter of FREDERICK AND ELEANORA PHILIPS BROWN of Benham Lodge died 29th May 1881 aged 5 years 8 months.

South: Also their Son REGINALD FREDERICK of Woodhays Whimble Devon aged 60 years and his Wife JANET EDITH died 21st Oct 1945.

West: FREDERICK PHILIPS BROWNE of Benham Lodge died 31st October 1884

Zone B. Grave 12. Shape of a cross. No visible inscription.

Zone B. Grave 13. In Memory of ELIZA the beloved wife of RICHARD BRADFORD who died oct 8th 1878 aged 72 years. "THY WILL BE DONE" also of RICHARD BRADFORD who died Oct 2nd 1888 aged 78 years AMELIA the beloved Wife of ROBERT DIXON she fell asleep August 31st 1855 aged 40 Years.

Zone B. Grave 14. Here resteth until the day break and the shadows flee away AMELIA the beloved wife of ROBERT DIXON she fell asleep August 31 – 1855 aged 40 years.

Zone B. Grave 15. Inscription difficult to read: To the memory of WILLIAM BROCKHURST who departed this life at CRANRU COTTAGE May 11th 1858 aged 70 years. Also of Phia..... Wife of the who departed this life August 12th 1869 in the 88th year of her age. BLESSED ARE THE DEAD WHICH ME IN THE LORD.

Zone B. Grave 16. The shape of a cross In memory of ANDREW GEORGE FREEMAN Safe (unable to read remaining inscription) born January 3rd 18.. died October 10th 1874.

Zone B. Grave 30. Sacred to the memory of MARY RELICT Wife of JAMES COSTIEF. of Theale & Daughter of CHURCH AND MARY WESTBURY: who died October 20th 1848 aged 59 years. 'LORD REMEMBER ME WHEN THOU COMEST INTO THE KINGDOM'.
